



Job Title: Crew Member – Log Home Restoration

Responsibilities include:

- Preparing products and job sites for blasting, staining, and chinking
- Site clean-up to remove debris and dust
- Daily equipment maintenance
- Moving hoses and making adjustments as necessary
- Media blasting with different media types on different types of surfaces
- Ensure safe working conditions by continuously inspecting the job site
- Washing, staining, sealing, and chinking log homes
- Remove finish by media blasting and possible chemical stripping
- Wood replacement with epoxy and matching wood
- Operation of chainsaw, other power, and hand tools
- Other Duties as assigned

General Duties:

- Understanding and execution of processes used for log home restoration (staining, chinking, caulking, masking, etc)
- Operating all necessary equipment safely and efficiently (paint sprayers, pressure washers, scaffolding, chink pumps, chainsaws, sanders, power tools, media blaster, etc)
- Set up, utilize, move, and take down ladders of various sizes, including extension ladders
- Safely and responsibly operate company trucks with bumper pull and gooseneck trailers
- Responsible for equipment care, maintenance, and organization

Skills & Knowledge

- Painting experience helpful but not required.
- Remodel or restoration construction helpful but not required.
- Prior experience with log construction desirable but not required (training will be provided)
- Travel required (Expenses, lodging and per diem)
- Basic Power and hand tool usage experience including how to read a tape measure.

Work Environment

- Lifting and carrying 50 lbs. routinely, occasionally >50lbs.
- Working at heights above 10 feet, including from extension ladders
- Some periods of overhead work
- Standing for extended periods

- Bending, crouching, kneeling, grasping regularly throughout the day
- Ability to work in a full range of environmental elements; temperatures have ranged from approximately 10 to 100 degrees Fahrenheit
- Frequently exposed to fumes or airborne particles (PPE is provided)
- Regularly working in outdoor weather conditions
- Work day up to 10 hrs
- Some weekend work may be required for travel
- Travel to job sites which may result in overnight stays (expenses, lodging, and per diem package)
- Work is often physically demanding
- Climbing stairs and ladders and operating in tight and awkward spaces at times.

Strong work ethic, attention to detail and safety, and willingness to learn is a must. Must be able to lift 45 pounds.

Work Hours:

- Monday through Friday
- Some weekends as necessary to meet deadlines.

Some travel may be required depending on contracts.

Pay is \$20-\$35 per hour depending on experience.
